1. Estynwyd groeso cynnes i bawb gan y Cadeirydd Alwyn Roberts. Roedd ymddiheuriadau gan Cyng Eurgain Haf Davies, Lona Harris, a Shan Jones

- d) **Cronfa Cefnogi Cyngorau Cymuned** – ystyriwyd ymhellach y gohebiaeth gan Liz Fenwick yn dilyn y cyfarfod ar y 12fed Fai, a phrisiau hysbysfwrdd gan Shan. Yn dilyn trafodaeth, roedd pawb yn hapus i fynd ymlaen, a gwelwyd y byddai yn beth da os allai Liz ddod atom gyda'r drafft cyntaf. Hefyd ymholi i gael bracet ar y cefn, i osgoi ei dyllu.

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Minutes of the Council Meeting held on Monday, 8 June 2026 at 7:30 p.m. in the Hall, Llanegryn

Present: Cllr Alwyn Roberts, William T Davies, Rhys Williams, WRP Jones, and Cllr Bethan Lawton (Gwynedd Council), together with Huw T Jones (Clerk).

1. Welcome and Apologies

The Chair, Alwyn Roberts, extended a warm welcome to everyone present. Apologies were received from Cllr Eurgain Haf Davies, Lona Harris, and Shan Jones.

There were no declarations of interest regarding any items on the agenda.

2. Public Participation

It was noted that no requests had been received from members of the public to make presentations on any agenda item.

3. Approval of Previous Minutes

The minutes of the Annual Meeting held on 27 April were approved on the proposal of William T Davies and seconded by WRP Jones.

4. Matters Arising

a) Highways Matters

Responses received to previous highways enquiries were noted.

Confirmation had been received from the Highways Department that “Unsuitable for Vehicles” signs would be installed at the bottom of Rhydycriw Road, Blaidd, and on the route from Pantgwyn to Ffordd Ddu, with signs placed at both ends.

b) Memorial Garden

An update was received regarding the application to install a plaque. The matter would need to be discussed further at the next meeting when a response had been received.

c) Community Transport Scheme

The latest developments regarding this project were reported, and it was noted that a meeting had been held on 1 June.

d) Community Council Support Fund

Further consideration was given to correspondence from Liz Fenwick following the meeting on 12 May, together with noticeboard quotations provided by Shan.

Following discussion, all members were happy to proceed and agreed that it would be beneficial if Liz could provide the first draft. It was also suggested that enquiries should be made about fitting a bracket on the back to avoid drilling through the board.

A draft grant application had been circulated to all councillors for a total of £5,331. It was noted that an additional £169 for installation of the sign could be included in the application.

e) Eryri Community Funds – Applications through the National Park

It was noted that the correspondence had been circulated to all members.

f) Huw Owen Fund

It was reported that information was available on the Gwynedd Council website and that details should be included in *Dail Dysynni* when the next application opportunity arises.

5. Planning Matters

There were no planning matters to consider.

6. Financial Matters

a) Account Balances

The account balances as of 22 May 2026 were noted:

- Current Account: £7,700.70
- Business Manager Account: £6,097.96

The Clerk had submitted a VAT reclaim, and a total of £1,536.50 had been received.

b) Invoices for Payment

On the proposal of WRP Jones, seconded by Rhys Williams, the following payments were approved:

- Clerk's first-quarter remuneration – £400.01
- HMRC – £100

c) Funding Requests

A funding request had been received from Kids Cancer Charity, and it was decided not to make a contribution.

7. Correspondence

a) The dates and training programme of One Voice Wales training sessions were noted.

b) Information had been received from Gwynedd Council regarding consultation on the Visitor Levy scheme, which the Clerk had circulated. A meeting would be held in Dolgellau on 3 July.

c) Correspondence had been received regarding a second consultation by Hywel Dda University Health Board concerning Stroke Services at Bronglais Hospital. A meeting would be held at Plas Machynlleth on 30 June between 2:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.

8. Any Other Business

- It was noted that someone was needed to cut the grass at the Memorial Garden and at the cycle parking site in Cefn Coch. It was agreed that Iwan Roberts could be asked to undertake the work at a cost of £40 per visit for both sites, with the work carried out once a month during the summer. (Cllr Alwyn Roberts declared an interest when this matter was discussed.)
