1. Estynwyd groeso cynnes i bawb gan y Cadeirydd Alwyn Roberts. Roedd ymddiheuriadau gan Cyng Lona Harris, Eurgain Haf Davies, WR P Jones a Shan Jones. Nid oedd unrhyw **ddatganiadau o ddiorderdeb** am faterion ar yr agenda.
2. Nodwyd nad oedd unrhyw gais i gael cyflwyniadau gan aelodau o'r cyhoedd ar fater ar yr Agenda.

DYDDIAD CYFARFOD NESAF; CYFARFOD BLYNYDDOL YN NEUADD LLANEGRYN NOS LUN 27ain Ebrill 2026 , 7.30y.h.

Minutes of the Council meeting held on Monday 23rd February 2026 at 7.30pm at the Hall, Llanegryn.

Present: Cllr Alwyn Roberts, William T Davies, Rhys Williams, Cllr Bethan Lawton (Gwynedd Council), together with Huw T Jones (Clerk)

1. A warm welcome was extended to everyone by the Chair, Alwyn Roberts. Apologies were received from Cllr Lona Harris, Eurgain Haf Davies, W.R.P. Jones and Shan Jones. There were no declarations of interest regarding items on the agenda.
2. It was noted that there were no requests from members of the public to make presentations on any agenda item.
3. The minutes of the meeting held on 26th January were confirmed on the proposal of Cllr William T Davies, seconded by Cllr Rhys Williams.

4. **Matters arising:**

a) **Highways Matters** – Responses to previous enquiries were noted, and it was understood that the Department should contact Cllr Alwyn Roberts for further details regarding the Cefn Llabwst road. The latest update regarding scaffolding at the Corbett Hotel in Tywyn was read.

b) **Memorial Garden** – The latest update regarding the request to install a plaque was noted, and it was agreed that this would need to be discussed at the next meeting.

c) **Community Transport Scheme** – An update on the project was reported, and everything was progressing well.

d) **Parking outside the Hall in Llanegryn** – A further response from the Environment Department of Gwynedd Council stated that they were unable to assist. It was necessary to determine how the Hall Committee could help with this matter. This item would be placed on the next agenda.

e) An update was noted following correspondence with Ysgol Craig yr Aderyn, and a contractor had arranged to cut trees on adjacent land.

5. **Planning Matters**

There were no matters to discuss.

6. **Financial Matters**

a) **Accounts 2024–25** – Correspondence from the External Auditor confirming that everything had been completed was noted. A public notice had been placed on the website, and posters had been displayed on the Llanegryn noticeboard.

- It was agreed to ask Gwynedd Council to carry out the internal audit again this year, and the Clerk would write to confirm.
- All those present confirmed that they did not wish to claim any costs or expenses for 2025–26.

b) **Invoices for payment**

On the proposal of Cllr Rhys Williams, seconded by Cllr William Davies, the following were agreed:

- Clerk's salary £401.01 for the last quarter, and HMRC £100.
- Clerk's expenses for the year 2025–26 – £500.
- E.W. Owen & Co – PAYE work – £252.00.

c) **Funding Applications**

- Meirionnydd Young Farmers Clubs – a contribution of £200 was agreed.

7. Correspondence

- a) Dates for One Voice Wales training sessions and the training plan were noted.
- b) An email from Steven Beech of Gwynedd Council inviting ideas for the Supporting Councils Fund grant scheme available in 2026–27 was noted. Among the suggestions mentioned were a new noticeboard in Llanegryn and Cefn Coch, and recycled benches for the common.
- c) Protecting Bronglais Services – the correspondence and latest news were noted.
- d) Eryri Local Development Plan – call for possible sites. The information was noted and would need to be placed on the next agenda.
- e) A wool celebration event at Glan-Llyn Camp, Bala, on 6th March was noted.

8. Any Other Business

- There was a water leak in the toilets, and Cllr Alwyn Roberts and Rhys Williams agreed to deal with this.
- Trees were leaning into the main road from land belonging to ‘Coed Bodywyn’. This needed to be referred to the Highways Department.
